If you are a Canadian citizen because you were born outside Canada to a Canadian parent, you will have to provide: A birth certificate that was issued by the government in the country where you were born and that lists your parents' names; Evidence that one parent was a Canadian citizen at the time of your birth.

Certificate of retention of Canadian citizenship (issued pre-1977); Certificate of registration of birth abroad . You must provide 1 photo ID document that includes your name, sex, date of birth, your signature, and be issued by a provincial/territorial/state government .
